SAFE SITTER BABYSITTING COURSE



Why is a babysitting course so important? Families in our community need responsible babysitters. The Babysitting Course will provide youth who are planning to babysit with the knowledge and skills necessary to safely and responsibly give care for children and infants. This training will help participants to develop leadership skills; learn how to develop a babysitting business, keep themselves and others safe, and learn about basic childcare and basic first aid. Babysitting classes are offered to students age 11 and older.

This 6-hour Babysitting Course will be 9 – 3 pm on Saturday, November 19th. A completion card is given to students who pass the verbal and hands – on session. The fee for this course is \$60.
