Raymond Recreation Vacation Week Camps



What's it all about??



Our goal is to keep your children engaged – socially, physically & mentally over the break.

The Raymond Recreation Vacation Week Camp is a day camp setting where children are in a safe, supervised, positive environment that allows them to grow and have fun! Our summer Playground staff will provide a diverse option of activities throughout the week. We will have sports, games, arts & crafts, movies, special events and a variety of trips. The school opens at 8:00 am and the latest pick up is 5:00 pm.

The registration fee for the week is **\$160**, which includes all trips and activities. You may also register for individual days, \$30 for each playground daze, \$45 for Xtreme Craze, \$45 for CEC & Movies and \$45 for Boston Children's Museum. There is an additional fee for vacation week camp shirts (see right)

Bounced Checks: The town of Raymond will charge a \$25 fee for any returned checks.

Who is Eligible?

To be eligible to attend, your child must be in kindergarten (born on or before September 30, 2018) or above. We will need to see a birth certificate for all first-time registrants.

To get the town rate, you also need to be a resident of Raymond. Everyone will be required to show proof of residency. Non-residents may register but they are charged a higher rate.

Camp Shirts



Once you have registered for our vacation week camp your child will need an official camp Tshirt or sweatshirt. \$15 each for shirt or sweatshirt and \$25 for both. It is not necessary for your child to wear the shirt on playground daze. It is, however, required that your child wear a recreation shirt on all field trip days. If a child does not have a shirt on a field trip, they will not be allowed to attend the trip (No refunds will be issued for participants not wearing their recreation shirt). If necessary, red summer playground shirts may also be worn.

Day Camp . . NOT Day Care! Behavioral Issues

We will make every attempt to work with participants and parents on any behavioral issue that may arise, but our number one responsibility is to provide a safe environment for ALL participants and staff. In extreme cases, participants may be suspended or expelled from the program. There will be NO REFUNDS given as a result of this action. So please, impress on your child the importance of behaving. Parents must be available to pick up their child, if necessary!



Lost & Found

We cannot be responsible for lost or stolen property. We do however have a lost and found box that ends up pretty full by the end of the week. If your child is missing something check with our staff or at the Rec office after camp.

What to bring

Campers are to bring a refillable water bottle, lunch and snacks every day unless otherwise noted. Keep in mind children are active throughout the day. Campers need to hydrate often and are very hungry by snack and lunch time. Participants also need appropriate clothing for both indoor and outdoor play including a pair of athletic shoes.

Field Trips



Our camp schedule can be a little confusing if you don't take the time to read through the packet and look at specific field trip information. In particular, check each day to see if you need to pack a lunch or if one is provided, what your child needs to be wearing or bring with them for the day.

Children must ride the bus to the trip and on the return home. No one will be allowed to pick up or drop off a child at the trip site.

If sending your younger child with money please put in a bag/wallet/envelope with child's name on it.

DO NOT SEND anything to camp that you do not want lost. broken or stolen including phones.

REFUNDS



The registration fee for the week of camp is non-refundable unless Raymond Recreation is notified before the camp begins. There will also be no daily refunds if your child does not attend a specific day. If you are registered at the daily rate you may request a refund with a 48-hour advanced notice. There will be **no refunds** given for children missing the bus.



Emergency Forms

These emergency forms are really important to us on a daily basis. Take the time to fill them out completely (double check phone numbers). If your child is sick or hurt, the faster we contact you the better they will feel.

We do not have a nurse on staff and cannot dispense any medication. If your child requires daily medication, please try to adjust his/her schedule so you can dispense it before leaving home in the morning.

Weather Policy



We understand the New England weather is very unpredictable. We will keep camp open unless the roads are too dangerous for travel. We do not want you or our staff to be driving in unsafe conditions. When possible, we will make every effort to notify you by email or phone. Field trips may be adjusted or cancelled. To check for possible trip cancellations or changes check our facebook page or call the Recreation office 895-7031 after 8:00 am.

The cost for the winter camp is \$160 for the entire week plus an additional fee if you need to purchase our vacation camp shirts. Children are required to wear either their vacation camp or summer playground shirt on each trip day. Non-resident's fee is an additional \$20 per week or additional \$5 per day. The last day to register is Thursday, April. 18th.

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

In consideration of the permission granted to the participant named above to participate in the RAYMOND RECREATION FIELD TRIP, I/we SHALL RELEASE, WAIVE DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE the Town of Raymond, Recreation Department, their agent and employees from all liability for any and all loss or damage, and any claim or demands therefore on account of injury to the person or property or resulting in death of the named participant except in the case of gross or willful wanton negligence of the Town of Raymond, Recreation Department its agents and employee or otherwise while the named participant participates in the RAYMOND RECREATION.

I/we further agree to indemnify the Town of Raymond, Recreation Department, their agents and employees from any and all liability, loss or damage including but not limited to bodily injury, illness, death or property damage which the Town of Raymond, Recreation Department, their agents and employees become legally obligated to pay including reasonable attorneys' fees and costs, as a result of claims, demands, costs or judgments, against the Town of Raymond, Recreation Department, their agents and employees on account of injury to the person or property or resulting in the death of the named participant except in the case of gross or willful wanton negligence of the Town of Raymond, Recreation Department, their agents or employees and whether or not such liability is sole, joint or several.

I/we am aware that participation in this program may present a strain on my child's body, or its parts and therefore I represent to the Town of Raymond, Recreation Department that to the best of my knowledge, my child is in a proper physical condition to allow him/her to participate and that I/we assume the risk of participating. I/we understand that the above program involves traveling to various activity sites. I/we will accept full responsibility for the transportation of my child to and from these activities and I/we release, indemnify and hold harmless and persons providing such transportation. I/we understand that in case of injury or illness, I/we will be notified. If it is impossible to contact me and it is an emergency, I/we hereby give permission to the attending physician to treat, hospitalize, administer anesthesia, or to order injections or surgery for the safety of my child.

I/we, the parent/legal guardian, the undersigned, have read this release and understand all its terms. I/we execute it voluntarily and with full knowledge of its significance. I/we have executed this release on this date indicated next to my/our names.

I understand that employees working at XtremeCraze, including the manager, do not have the authority to waive any provision of this Agreement. This Agreement constitutes and contains the entire agreement between XtremeCraze and you relating to the Child's and my use of the XtremeCraze Facility.

5. You acknowledge that the owners and operators of XTREMECRAZE have employed diligent efforts and care in making the facilities and premises as safe as possible; and that despite the foregoing efforts, you understand that there are, nevertheless, certain inherent risks in using the facilities and premises. Among these risks are possible trips, falls, scrapes, collisions with other people or objects, etc. You specifically acknowledge the existence of these risks and agree to the use of the premises and facilities with the full understanding of the potential risks.

6. You agree to accept and assume all the risks which accompany the Park's activities and represent that your participation in the activities is purely voluntary and you elect to participate in the activities notwithstanding the risks.

That if you or your property are injured while using the premises and facilities as a result of the inherent risks and dangers mentioned above, you agree to RELEASE from Liability, INDEMNIFY, AND HOLD HARMLESS Hughes entertainment, Inc., and Good Fun LLC. dba XTREMECRAZE, its employees, assigns, and affiliated entities FROM SAID INJURIES OR ANY COSTS OR EXPENSES ASSOCIATED THEREWITH.

8. TERM OF AGREEMENT I understand that this agreement extends forever into the future and will have full force and legal effect each and every time I or my child(ren)/ward(s) visit XtremeCraze, whether at the current location or any other location or facility

IN SUMMARY, BY SIGNING THIS FORM, I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT IF I OR ANY OF MY CHILDREN ARE INJURED IN ANY WAY, THIS WAIVER PREVENTS AND PROHIBITS ANY RECOVERY OF MONEY FROM ANY XTREMECRAZE RELATED ENTITY.

DO NOT SIGN THIS ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND RELEASE UNLESS YOU HAVE READ IT AND UNDERSTAND IT. IF YOU DON'T UNDERSTAND IT, ASK AN XTREMECRAZE REPRESENTATIVE FOR ASSISTANCE.
