THE PROGRAM

Why Raymond Recreation?

We believe that summer should be a fun, relaxing time where kids can just be kids. Camp gives them the opportunity to socialize with children their own age while in a safe, supervised, and positive environment that helps them grow and have fun.

Children are at less risk in camp where they have a sense of community, develop relationships with their peers and counselors, and learn through first-hand experiences. Our trained, caring counselors become role models that help children feel accepted, capable, and included.

Program Dates/Hours/Location

Raymond Summer Playground runs for seven weeks from Monday, June 27 through Thursday, August 11. There will be no Program held on Monday, July 4th. Playground hours are from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm. There are a few exceptions with some field trip days.

We operate our program in two separate programs based on the grade your child will be entering in the fall. Your child will be assigned to a group for the summer. We are planning state park trips on Mondays and field trips on Wednesdays for students entering grades 1-3. For grade 4 and above state parks will be Tuesdays and field trips on Thursdays. Our summer programs (all groups) will be located at the Iber Holmes Gove Middle, 1 Stephen K Batchelder Pkwy, Raymond, NH.

Age Groupings

Our program is divided into groups by the grade they are entering in the fall of 2022.

Elementary School Program:

Blue Group 1st grade
Red Group 2nd grade
Orange Group 3rd grade

Middle School Program:

Green Group 4th grade
Yellow group 5th grade
Purple group 6th grade
Rec'n Crew 7th - 9th grade

Late Fees

Children must be picked up at 3:00 pm. After 3:20, you will be assessed a fine of \$10 for every 10-minute window you are late. (3:25 pm = \$10, 3:45 pm = \$30). This includes field trips with a later return time. We allow a 20-minute grace period to pick up your child. After the 20 minutes have past the late fees are assessed.

If we do have to collect a fine, you will be issued paperwork letting you know the amount of the fine. The paperwork along with the fine must be returned to the Playground Secretary or Rec office within 48 hours. If the fine is not paid, your child will not be allowed to attend the playground.

This fine will not be assessed in cases of family emergencies, or legitimate circumstances. In these cases, please call the Recreation Office at 895-7031 or the Raymond Police Department at 895-4747 and they will relay a message to the playground as to your expected time of arrival.

Before & After Rec Care

We will be offering before & after rec care for all participants. Before rec care will be open from 7:00 – 8:00 am; after rec care will be immediately after the playground until 5:30 pm. All participants must be picked up by 5:30 pm. We cannot be responsible for children staying that are not registered for before or after rec care.

Check-in & Check-out

Raymond Rec's summer program meets outside by the walkway on the right of the gymnasium. Park in the large parking lot and walk your child/ren to check-in with their group. Please do not drive or park in the bus lane. The bus lane is reserved for busses for our program and the school. Morning check-in and afternoon check-out are done by your child's counselor. If you bring your child to the playground after 8:20 am you must check him/her in with the playground secretary or site director. Please remember to always check your child in and out with a staff member.

Pick-up time at the end of the day can be a little hectic. Please be aware and make others picking up your child/ren aware that the parking lot could be dangerous during this time. There are cars, busses, parents, and lots of very excited and tired kids.

Parent/guardians of 1st, 2nd, & 3rd graders – please park your car, walk over to greet your child, sign them out with their counselor and then walk with them across the parking lot. For the safety of all the children please take these few extra steps.

Pick up policy for 4th grade and above: participants must tell their counselor if they are being picked up, walking or riding their bike. Those being picked up must point out to their counselor who is picking them up. Counselors will record this information on the check-in list.

PARTICIPANT INFORMATION

The Raymond Recreation Summer Playground is here to provide enriching and rewarding experiences to our participants as well as nurture positive interaction and communication between the participant and the summer staff.

Camp Expectations

Campers are expected to behave in a safe, responsible, respectful manner toward themselves and others. This will be demonstrated by listening to the directions of staff, remaining in designated camp boundaries and having fun. If your child sometimes has behavior difficulties, please help all of us by filling out our **Behavior Tips and Tools form**.

Every effort will be made to ensure that campers have an enjoyable experience at camp. In extreme cases, a child may need a day or more out of camp in order to regroup. In the event that a camper receives a temporary suspension, parents/guardians will be called and asked to pick their child up. In some situations, the active group environment of summer camp is not an ideal fit for a child. Please remember, when you sign your child up for the playground this doesn't relinquish you of responsibility for your child during the day. In the event we need to have you pick up your child, you must be able to make arrangements for them.

Blue Box

Raymond Recreation's Summer Playground strives to provide a safe and healthy environment for all participants and staff involved. We have a strict policy for bullying and abusive behaviors. Participants will be given clear expectations and guidance by staff to help them understand and follow the rules and behavioral expectations of the program. Our camp uses a system called the "Blue Box" to address, track and modify behaviors that are found to be unsafe or inappropriate for the camp environment and its participants. If a camper's behavior created problems for themselves, other campers or staff, a card will be written up and put in the "Blue Box". Staff will complete the card with camper's name, a brief description of the issue and the follow up action taken.

Behavior Issues & Policy

We will make every attempt to work with participants and parents on any behavioral issue that may arise, but our number one responsibility is to provide a safe environment for ALL participants and staff. In extreme cases, participants may be suspended or expelled from the program. There will be NO REFUNDS given as a result of this action. So please, impress on your child the importance of behaving. Parents must be available to pick up their child, if necessary!

After a disciplinary suspension, the Participant and a Parent/Guardian will meet with the Assistant Recreation Director & Site Director to come up with a positive plan to modify behaviors. All parties will go over and sign the *Behavioral Management Policy*.

If your child has any health or mental deficits that may affect his/her ability to follow behavioral expectations, please identify them on the *Behavior Tips & Tools Form*. We are unable to accommodate one on one care during our program but are willing to work with parents on plans or strategies, when possible, that may help the child be successful during their camp experience.

Parent/Guardian Communication

Communication, cooperation, and teamwork are a critical part of the Parent/Guardian - Program relationship. Our staff appreciates parents/guardians who keep us informed of their child's special circumstances or any transitions in the home life. This keeps us plugged in and sensitive to your child's needs.

Parents must contact the office when

- Information on your registration has changed.
- Someone other than those listed on your emergency form will be picking up your child. Please also send a note to your child's counselor or email the recreation office.
- A child is not able to be picked up on time.
- An incident or change occurs in your child's life that alters his/her attitude or behavior or causes severe distress.
- Emotional upset (e.g., divorce, loss of a pet, death in the family).
- Your child is contagious (e.g., head lice, pinkeye, chicken pox). Please do not send your child with ANY contagious illness, including but not limited to these examples, for the health and safety of staff and other participants

Parents will be contacted when

- Your child has received an injury which could require immediate medical attention and/or EMTs have been called. We ask that if we do have to contact you regarding an emergency that you would immediately come and attend to your child.
- Your child exhibits a medical condition which could be contagious or threatening to others in the program.
- Your child is ill and is unable to participate in daily activities.
- Your child acts out of appropriate behavior and is causing disturbance to the well-being of the program or has violated the behavior contract.

EMERGENCY INFO & MEDICATION POLICY

The most important form you fill out when registering your child is our emergency form. Please take the time to fill them out completely. If your child is sick or hurt, the faster we contact you the better they will feel. In the unlikely event we need to call you, and have you pick up your child, you must be able to make arrangements for them.

Do not send your child to camp if they are sick or not feeling well. Stomach bugs, strep throat, pink eye, head lice, and fevers can spread quickly through campers.

Due to liability issues, counselors are not permitted to dispense medication of any kind to campers. If possible, adjust his/her schedule so you can dispense it earlier or later in the day. If your child needs to take medication at a certain time of day, please review instructions with your child. You can request their counselor to remind them if necessary. Counselors can NOT carry camper's medication. We ask that parents place the daily dose of medication in a secured container (labeled clearly with instructions) and place in the same location in the backpack each day. If your camper requires an inhaler or epinephrine, and needs assistance, speak with the site director.

A DAY AT CAMP

Sample Playground day (all times are approximate):

- 8:00 am the children arrive and check in with their group leader.
- 8:30 am group meeting and the children are broken into groups for station games. These games run about 25 minutes and the children are rotated through activities with different staff. These activities include water games, running games, circle games, and arts and crafts.
- 10:00 am we break for snack and some free time. Each color is called to grab a snack and drink from their lunch box. Children are also encouraged to use the bathroom at this time and reapply sunscreen. Staff will assist children with SPRAY sunscreen only.
- 10:40 am another set of station games
- 12:00 pm free time into lunch. At lunch the children eat outside or in the café. Once they are done eating, they are encouraged to use the bathroom and reapply sunscreen. Please send your child with healthy options and hydrating drinks. It can be a long and hot day for your little ones and good sources of energy are needed. If your child is refusing to eat what is packed or is in need of a few extra items a note will be sent home in their lunch bag, so you are aware.

- 1:00 pm Afternoon activity; this is the event listed on the Rec calendar. Sometimes the theme is incorporated throughout the day as well, but the children also have a group activity in the afternoon.
- 2:00 pm- after the afternoon activity ends the children have free play time until checkout
- 3:00 pm checkout; the group leaders will be out front with their clipboards.

PLEASE MAKE SURE WHEN YOUR CHILD ARRIVES AND LEAVES THAT YOU CHECK IN/OUT WITH A STAFF MEMBER. If your child is not checked out, you will receive a phone call confirming your child is with you.

What your child should bring to camp (Make sure you label everything!!)

Clothing & footwear

- Children should dress in comfortable clothes they can get dirty. **Sneakers** are highly encouraged every day, as camp is very active. Sandals must have proper back straps and allow for children to run and play safely. Flip flops and crocs are **only** allowed on beach days. Please be sure that your child is dressed appropriately for field trips and special events. Specific information about each trip can be found on the registration form or back of the calendar.

Sunscreen

- For the safety of the children, please apply sunscreen to your child before coming to camp. Children are expected to have sunscreen with them at the camp to re-apply throughout the day. Spray sunscreen is Best! (staff will not rub lotion on your child)

Water Bottle

- Hydration is essential! All children should bring a refillable water bottle to camp each day labeled with their first and last name. Days can be long and hot, and more fluids are necessary under these circumstances. Water bottles can be filled or refilled by the water station outside.

Lunches & Snacks

- The camp day is active and tiring; therefore healthy, nutritious food choices are very important for children. Lunchtime usually begins around noon. A small cooler or lunch box with an ice pack and your child's name on it will make identification easier. Please pack a healthy lunch with plenty to drink. We also take a short break in the morning for snack around 10:00 am.
- We sell water, Gatorade, and snacks during snack time and lunch. We also sell ice cream novelties after lunch. Ice cream novelties will be between \$1 - \$3, children will only be allowed to purchase one ice cream per day.

Sweatshirt / change of clothes

- Summer mornings in New England can be chilly, so we suggest bringing a sweatshirt. We also recommend packing an extra change of clothes and even a towel for water activity days.

Toys & Money

We cannot be responsible for lost or stolen property. This includes the trading, selling or buying of toys, phones, games, etc. We suggest valuable or treasured toys be left at home.

Please talk with your child about money; specifically, a safe way to store it. If you send your younger child with money, please put it in a Ziploc baggie with their name on it (counselors will also have extra baggies in their clip boards). For field trips, the younger children are encouraged to give their money to their staff member. This is to help cut down on lost money and is easier for staff to keep track of while on trips. Please remind your child not to ask for or share money with other participants.

Cell Phones

Cell phones should be left at home. If a participant must bring a cell phone to the Playground, please make sure they store it with their stuff. To ensure responsible cell phone use, participants may only use their cell phone during lunch, on bus rides and after the program.

Lost & Found

The amount of lost and found that we gather through the summer is wild so please help us out and label your child's items so we can get them back to their group tables. Make sure to check the lost and found on a daily basis.

Inclement Weather Policy

The playground will stay open on rainy days. We will have limited space indoors. Outdoor field trips may be adjusted or cancelled. To check for possible trip cancellations/changes check on the Raymond Recreation Facebook page or call the Recreation Office 895-7031 after 8 am.

FIELD TRIP INFORMATION

- We will be offering one field trip per week for Blue, Red & Orange groups and one field trip per week for Green, Yellow, Purple & Rec'n Crew Groups. We will also offer an additional weekly field trip for Rec'n Crew kids, grade 7 and above.
- Field trips will be an additional cost and you will need to fill out a registration form for each trip. Make sure to read all information on all field trip registration forms. Please remember the playground is closed on field trip days (all of our staff is on the trip). Save the top portion of your forms! They contain a lot of information specific to the trip itself.
- All of our trips have limits to the number of children we can take and once we are full, we're full. On popular trips, that could happen very quickly. We will begin a waitlist, but spaces will only be filled if we have cancellations. We do not take registrations for trips on the day of the trip.
- Field trip registrations may be done at the Recreation Office (before camp - *first two trips only*) or with the Playground Secretary (once camp begins). **Playground Secretary is at the middle school Monday through Friday 8:00–9:30 am. PLEASE DO NOT bring trip registration forms to the Rec Office after June 24.**
- **Field trips can be registered up to 2 weeks in advance or you can purchase our summer field trip package to guarantee a spot on every trip.**
- There will be no transfers or refunds given if you miss a trip with the summer trip package.
- All trips bus times are located on the state park form, calendar and field trip forms.
- Upon arrival to camp children are asked if they have their rec shirt, lunch and necessary change of clothes for our destination. For example; bathing suit, towel, lunch, socks, sneakers, water bottle. If you child is missing any necessary items, you will be asked to take your child with you to retrieve the items and return before the bus is scheduled to leave.

- While on field trips your child is expected to follow our rules and any specific bus safety rules.
- Participants in the younger groups (blue, red, orange, green) are always with a counselor. Participants in yellow and purple (may) and those in Recon Crew (will) have the opportunity to walk around an enclosed area or park with a buddy or a group of friends. We have counselors around the area and are very strict on our check-in policy. Most students rise to the point of being independent and self-reliant. Your help in reminding your child to stay with a buddy: be responsible; and to check in with their counselors will be very helpful. Please feel free to talk with the director about any concerns for your child as other arrangements can be made.
- Upon our return to the school please do not crowd around the bus doors. Please wait for your child at their color check in/out area. This will make the check-out process much easier and cause less confusion and stress to staff and parents.
- Your child **MUST** wear their playground shirt on all field trips. Children must also ride the bus to the trip and on the return home. No one will be allowed to be picked up or dropped off at trip sites. **SO, DO NOT MISS THE BUS!**

Field Trip Payments

We love Checks! Checks are much easier to deal with than cash. We do not deposit the checks for specific trips until the date of the field trip. This means you can date the check for the date of the trip. If the trip is canceled, you can come to the playground and pick it up. If you do need to send cash, ***please send the exact amount since we carry very little change.***

If you are paying by check we need separate check for each field trip (unless you pay our summer trip package). We know this can be confusing for your bookkeeping system but just think what it is like for us with nearly 250+ kids going on two or three different trips a week. Separate checks make it easier to deal with cancellations and refunds when necessary. Field trip checks are payable to **Raymond Recreation**.

Bounced Checks: The Town of Raymond charges a \$25 fee for any returned checks.

Field Trip Refunds

Once you have registered for a trip you can only get a refund by notifying the playground secretary (or calling the recreation office 895-7031) at least twenty-four hours in advance of the trip. Please do not ask a counselor or anyone else to tell the office, you need to do this personally. There will be no refunds given for children missing the bus. Pick up your refund from the secretary at the playground.

- **DO NOT SEND** anything you do not want lost, broken or stolen including phones.

The fee is \$15 per day or \$35 for the entire week. The registration fee includes supervision, games and morning snack.


