DISC GOLF

Interested in trying disc golf? We have our very own course right here in Raymond! Check out the Cam Baer Memorial Disc Golf Course at Riverside Park. Raymond Rec and RCFY will be "renting" (for free) 3-disc sets for residents to try disc golf before purchasing your own. You may also sign out disc sets at the Dudley-Tucker Library, bring your license or school ID.

What is disc golf? Similar to ball golf, the object of disc golf is to throw your disc from the starting point (tee pad) all the way into the basket (the hole) in as few throws as possible. Players use discs, often referred to as drivers, mid-ranges, or putters to make their shots. The person who has the lowest score at the end wins.
